

## Four tasks to defeat oligarchs

Last week's Strategy Note 297 said we have a competition for what kind of new system will replace the failing old exploitative system. It said the oligarchs actively push for their preferences and we must out-organize them.

Regular people --especially working people and our unions-- need to build four things to win that competition:

- Widespread accurate understanding of the causes of the current crisis (so people won't accept the oligarchs' false scapegoating).
- Widespread general agreement on what we want. (Our goal.)
- Widespread general agreement on how to get what we want. (Our strategy.)
- Widespread organizations that generally use our strategy to achieve our goal.

We need to work on these four things simultaneously, not sequentially. For example, we need the widespread organizations in the fourth task to accomplish the other three tasks.
