

Thank President Trump for ...

Last week's Strategy Note 312 said the time has come to accelerate growth of our exchange-free solidarity economy *and* to accelerate widespread understanding of the shift from exchange to solidarity.

Transitions like this grow slowly over a long time and then -- sooner than most people expect-- the balance shifts and the transition dramatically accelerates.

We haven't yet reached that tipping point but conditions accelerate. Some big change will happen soon. We either eliminate exchange soon (possibly within a decade) or our more extreme opponents will create a new era of oppression to delay our victory.

We can thank President Trump for disrupting the United States government --a major enforcer of exchange worldwide-- and for hastening its decline. We probably cannot return to pre-Trump conditions. Nor should we want to. The world in 2016 and 2024 did not serve most people well.

Trump operates within the declining exchange economy. He does not *intend* to support our cause. He may order attacks on us. Yet he demonstrates vividly the brittleness of exchange, its anti-democratic tendency, and the need to rapidly expand solidarity economic relationships to replace the failing old exchange economy.



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
